Miami-Dade County operates two large oceanfront parks, Crandon and Haulover. Naturist (clothing-optional) use of an area of Haulover Park began July, 1991. Within 3 years, from 1991 to 1994, parking revenue from Haulover increased 120% (\$258K to \$587K), and surpassed adjacent Crandon Beach, which increased only 6% (\$343K to \$363K).

Notes about the chart's timeline above:

- July 14, 1991: Initial naturist beach use at Haulover Park:
- April 15, 1992: Miami-Dade Police Department legal note #92-4 clarifies inapplicability of Florida Statute 800.03 to mere nudity absent lewd or lascivious behavior:
- December, 1993: Installation of first permanent naturist beach signs by Park Department
- The larger parallel increases in both Haulover & Crandon parking revenue represents parking fee increases over this period: \$2 per car in 1992, \$4 per car in 2000, \$5 per car in 2004.

Parks has not provided information about parking revenue after 2004. That last year parking revenue at Haulover was **\$1,148,073** compared to Crandon's \$696,297. A modest 3% annual increase each year means Haulover's parking revenue for 2008 is projected to be \$ 1,292,166.
